VETERINARY INSPECTION

Was your stallion born in or after 2015?

Before starting his breeding career, he **MUST** have a **VETERINARY INSPECTION** to confirm the absence of prognathism, brachygnathism, and cryptorchidism. The stallion must be at least two years old at the time of inspection.

PLEASE NOTE: Without this inspection, and report, his offspring cannot be registered!

Complete and submit *Form 008*

STALLION REPORT

The Stallion Report (*Form 007*) lists the mares served during the breeding season.

It initiates the automatic sending of birth declarations to the owners of the pregnant mares. **THIS ALLOWS THE REGISTRATION OF FOALS BORN THE FOLLOWING YEAR.**

As a stallion owner, it is your **DUTY** and your **RESPONSIBILITY** to complete this report and submitting it no later than December 31st, each year. Any delays or non-submission will be subject to additional fees.

BREEDING CONTRACT

Do you breed to outside mares?

Consider using a breeding contract that outlines the terms of the agreement with the mare owner (e.g., payment, guarantees, responsibilities in the event of injury to the mare or stallion). A contract helps avoid misunderstandings and unpleasant situations!

FROZEN SEMEN

Have you collected your stallion and froze the semen?

Remember to inform the Canadian Livestock Records Corp (CLRC), no later than 1 month after the date of freezing (*Form 010*).

GELDING

Did you have your stallion gelded ?

You must report this to the CLRC to **update the horse's status** in the registry.

Simply send an email to: info@lechevalcanadien.ca listing the name of the horse and his registration number. **The process is simple and free!**
